Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM

Approval of Minutes

The April, 2016 minutes were approved.

Borough Council Liaison Update and Discussion

Ms. James said there was no new information for her to present from Borough Council.

Mission Driven Projects, Events and Activities: Deliverables Gallery shows:

Beyond Cold Polished Stones

Ms. Halsey is fairly confident that the upcoming show be a success, and will bring a lot of visibility to the Borough. Ms. Weedon mentioned that the Carpenters Team is interested in sponsoring the show, details to follow. Ms. Halsey confirmed that gallery show artists will help gallery sit. TC Campuzano will gallery sit on July 4th. The Coordinator will create a volunteer sign up form for the board and Mr. Campuzano to use to sign up gallery sitters. Ms. Halsey will check with Mr. Campuzano about what hashtags he wants for the show. Ms. Weedon will forward any hashtags created by the PR consultant, Rachel Dukeman, and will work with the Borough to create artist letters for each show participant. Mrs. Coats asked whether there would be hooks in the ceiling from which to hang work. Ms. Hughes will create a form to be used for artwork labels.

Spoken Word Gatherings - Rachée Fagg

Ms. Halsey and Ms. Weedon had recent conversations with Ms. Fagg about the upcoming series.

Ms. Halsey noted that Ms. Fagg is not interested in sitting on the Arts Board. The board agreed not to charge Ms. Fagg for the use the building in exchange for free PR and outreach. The series will likely bring in a young and diverse crowd, and provide the Arts Board and the building significant visibility. Details from the spring planning meeting (Ms. Fagg and Ms. Weedon):

Story Slam Details

Each event to run on Friday evenings, 7:30 - 10pm, once a month. Promote the events through social media, and use spoken word festivals to get the word out: the idea is that people just want places to tell stories. Offer a training workshop - or a series of workshops - and then people get to tell their stories after learning how to do it well. 20*20 House space will be an intimate, space. Possibly have a guest MC each month - someone who is locally well known and connected? Have a theme for the evening, advertise it everywhere that people do storytelling, spoken word, etc.

Story Slam Calendar, 2016-17

- May do designs, get the word out, plan for marketing, postcard, social media, etc.
- July workshop for people interested in storytelling. Part commercial for upcoming story slam, part instruction: step by step of what makes good storytelling. Rachee Fagg to lead the workshop.
- August start date "Dog Days of Summer"

- Oct Costumes/Masks
- Nov "Family"
- Dec "Gifts"
- Jan "New Beginnings/Starting Over/New Year, New You..."

Story Slam Questions:

Do a junior story slam in the spring? Do story slams with specific guidelines (21 and up), suggested donation, etc. Have performers pay to perform? Charge entree fee?

Ms. Weedon will distribute printmaking blocks to Mrs. Coats, Ms. Winters and Ms. Halsey. Mrs. Coats, Ms. Hughes, Mr. Patterson and Ms. Haley will volunteer for the Printmaking days. Ms. Weedon will bring supplies. Mrs. Coats will provide clothespins and string. Bags to be printed on, not paper. Ms. Weedon will reach out to LEDC blurb about printmaking during

Community Day for newsletter, and will request a table under the tree. Ms. Weedon will also post on FaceBook about the event and activities.

Elisabeth Nickles

Ms. Weedon will check with Ms. Nickles about having the opening of her show on Saturday, September 11, from 4-6pm.

The Photography of Lansdowne Resident Ben Hovell, curated by Matt Schultz

Mark Gavin will print the images for the show. Mr. Schultz will have the pieces framed by a family member. Ms. Weedon will check with Mr. Schultz about when to do an artist's talk and opening for the show, possibly the weekend after Thanksgiving.

Christmas Carol

The Arts Board decided to host Jared Reed's one man performance of *A Christmas Carol* on Friday, December 23, from 6-8pm. Ms. Weedon will follow up with artist negotiations.
