Approval of Minutes

Borough Council Liaison Update and Discussion

 No Borough Council update from Ms. Williams. Ms. Hughes shared an update from the Lansdowne Democratic Committee: with Tangela James and Eric Aubrey on leave from BC, the recent and immediate departure of Bob Radich from Borough Council, along with Ms. Williams' heavy work travel schedule, BC has limited ability to formally vote on any issues at this time. This could have significant implications for LAB's functioning as we head into budget season.

Creative Placemaking

• No updates to report. Tyler activities are expected to resume later in the fall when the next batch of graduate students are on board.

Mission Driven Projects, Events and Activities - Gallery shows:

- Canfield & Carpenter show: The show is up and ready to go public at the opening on September 16. The board discussed having the gallery open on Friday, November 24, in conjunction with A Bit of the Arts. Ms. Hughes offered to gallery sit from 4-8pm that evening to make the event possible.
- Jodi Throckmorton juried series: 8 of the 75 artists who applied to the call for artists were selected for solo gallery shows in 2018-2020. Scheduling the

shows is currently underway. The website has been updated, and the artists are eager to show their work!

- Writer's series. Ms. Weedon presented the board with a draft plan for 2018 programming, including consulting from Leigh Jackson to develop the program. The NanNoWriMo series has been put on hold until 2018. It is possible that Ms. Hughes will offer to host a series of evening events at the 20*20 House to jump start NaNoWriMo, she will get back to the board about whether this is feasible given her schedule.
- Lansdowne Women in the Arts The Coordinator presented a draft overview and budget for BC to review.
- 125th Anniversary Show - The Coordinator presented a draft overview and budget for BC to review.

Administrative

- Next meetings: Mr. Patterson announced his plans to step down from being Board chair in January. He is unsure whether he will continue to be on the board or not.
- Building: Ms. Weedon shared that finishing the basement is expected to be contracted out. Ms, Halsey will work with Ms. Weedon to create external signage, both on the street level and on the building.
